Impossible because....

Mary was a _____ . (vs. 18a & 25)

This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together she was found to be with child. Joseph did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife, but he had no union with her until she gave birth to a son.

Mary was going to become pregnant _____ some kind of _____ . (vs. 18b & 20)

But before they came together, she was found to be pregnant with child through the Holy Spirit. An angel of the Lord appeared to him (Joseph) in a dream and said, Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

Mary's baby would _____ up to be a man, take _____ out of people, and be _____. (vs. 21 & 22)

She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins. All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel (which means "God with us").

Statement of belief: Mary was a virgin, who became pregnant through the Holy Spirit, gave birth to a son and gave him the name Jesus. Jesus is God's son who came to save all people from their sins.
