Ephesians 2:10

Read Ephesians 2:10.

1. If God has a list for us, what are some of the things that you think would be on yours?
2. How does God’s list differ from other to-do lists that we receive?

Read John 10:10.

3. How does doing the works of God contribute to living a life that is full? How has this actually played out in your life? Give an example.
4. Pastor Randy says “Sometimes we are not ready for the works God gives us to do because we are not yet the people God intends us to be.” How do you think this is so?

Read the change verses in Galatians 4:19, Romans 12:2, Romans 8:29.

5. What do these verses say about God’s desire for us? How do we actually change? How have you actually changed?
6. Have you ever thought about your personality and temperament as a gift from God? What keeps you from thinking of it as this? How are the strengths in your personality also weaknesses? What do you think of the statement that God wants you to become more you, not less you? What do you think this means?
7. Share a story about something you have seen restored. How is

God the master restorer? Can you think of any examples in Scripture that show this side of God?

Read Romans 8:18-23.

8. What is God’s desire for his whole creation? When God restores you, it affects much more than you. How is this true? How do we actually join God in recreating the world?
9. Read Jeremiah 1:5 and Psalm 139:13. What do you learn in these passages? How should these passages affect the way we live?
10. What do you want to become? What would be a first step in that direction?
